'A Day with Hot Lunch' Sponsors needed - Can you help?

Please allow us a few moments of your time to introduce you to SEWA and one of our charity projects.

Sofia Expat Women's Association (SEWA) is a non-profit organization with members currently, representing over 20 countries. The aims and objectives of the Association are to offer friendship and support to expat women living in Bulgaria and to promote mutual understanding of our host country's culture, traditions and life style. As well as introducing members to the culture, traditions and lifestyle of each other's countries, SEWA aims to support the community in need.

One of our unique projects is called "A Day with Hot Lunch". We created this program to be able to serve 120 portions hot lunch, once a month, to 120 people in need. We raised 900 BGN from 14 members on the first day of our campaign. We were hounered that even in the first month of our fund raising, we raised more than 2400 BGN; which cover 2 months of the project.

On April 12th, our partner "Study Kitchen" of Maria's World Foundation, prepared chicken soup, moussaka, a homemade cookie and two slices of bread for each bag.

The second hot lunch was on May 13th. This time the menu was potato cream soup with cheese, meat with cabbage, cake and bread.

SEWA members helped with the packaging, sorting and delivery of the food with our cars included the places listed below;

Pink House (Center for adicted and homeless people in Nadejda)

Displaced Ukrainian Families (Nadejda - 141 School)

Hope For The Little Ones (Ovcha Kupel)

Social Park Nadejda and Day Care Center (Nadejda)

Displaced Ukrainian Families (House being run by Municipality of Dragalevtsi)

Modern Family Type of Accomodation Center (Nadejda)

Special School "Eduard Segen" (Nadejda)

"Social Center Open Doors" in Soft Uni (Mladost)

Together with our partner, Maria's World Foundation, we are in contact with Sofia and Nadejda Minucipalities, Family type of Homes, Social Centers, Day Care Centers and other institutions, where we can deliver the hot lunches.

SEWA with it's members and friends would like to continue the success of this project. For this we need your help!



We believe that with the 'womanpower' of SEWA we will be able to continue to arrange the date, menu, packing and delivery of the lunches every month, but we need to secure the monetary part of the project through a professional / corporate donor.
